
On Monday, September 30, 2013 at approximately 2000 hours, Greenfield Officers were dispatched to the area of Maple Avenue and El Camino Real on a report of an armed robbery involving a knife. Officers located the 34 year old adult victim who was not injured during the incident.

One of the suspects grabbed the victim from behind and held a knife to the victim's throat and demanded all his money. The victim told the suspects that he did not have any money at which time the suspects grabbed the victim's phone and they left the area in a green SUV. All three suspects were arrested without incident at three different locations in the City of Greenfield.

During the preliminary investigation, Greenfield Officers were able to identify all three suspects involved in the armed robbery. The victim's property was recovered during the investigation.

Armando Pacheco Rios, D.O.B: 8.28.1975 was booked in the Monterey County Jail and charged with the following charges:

- Armed Robbery
- Assault with a Deadly Weapon
- Intimidation of a Witness
- Damaging a wireless device

On Saturday, September 07, 2013 at approximately 0336 hours, Greenfield Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Oak Avenue on a report of a shooting. Officers found a victim who had been shot numerous times.

Victim, Julio Rodarte, age 29 sustained non-life threatening injuries and was flown to a bay area hospital for medical treatment.

During the preliminary investigation, Greenfield Officers were able to identify the suspect in the attempted homicide investigation.

## Update: Attempted Murder Investigation


During the course of the investigation, Greenfield Police obtained an arrest warrant with a bail amount of \$2,200,000 for the suspect. On Friday, September, 27, 2013 at approximately 1150 hours, Officers from the Greenfield Police Department with the assistance from two agents from the United States Marshal's Office arrested the suspect without incident at his place of employment.

On Friday, September 27, 2013, two search warrants were executed at two different residences in the City of Greenfield in connection with the attempted murder investigation. During further investigation, officers discovered several items related to the investigation.

Mark Anthony Raso, was arrested for the attempted murder and booked in the Monterey County Jail and was charged with the following charges:

- Attempted Murder
- Firearm used in the commission of a felony
- Assault with a Firearm during a violent felony
- Participation in Criminal Street Gang Activity
- Promote a Criminal Street Gang Activity by committing violent felony for the benefit of the gang


