Timeline of Implementation

- **Set up dedicated page on website** (“CVRA page”)
- **Prepare an FAQ for the public** (available on CVRA page)
- **Informational meeting** before the January 31 Pre-Map Hearing?
 - *(City Council to decide)*
- **Pre-Map Hearing #1 – January 31, 2022**
 - Purpose to inform public about City’s transition plan and receive public input re: the composition of the potential districts
 - The City’s demographer will give a presentation that describes
 - The overall transition process
 - The roll of the demographer
 - The specific criteria and considerations that demographer will utilize during the map creation process (public will have opportunity to provide input re: drafts)

Timeline of implementation (continued)

- **Pre-Map Hearing #2 – February 3, 2022**

- Similar to Hearing #1

- Demographer will repeat the same presentation (public will have 2nd opportunity to provide input)

- After this Hearing, the City Council will have provided the demographer direction regarding criteria for the maps

- This would include if Council would like 5 districts vs. 4 districts plus an at-large mayor (or wants to consider both options)

Timeline of implementation (continued)

- **Map Preparation**
 - Demographer prepares the maps
- **Map Review Hearing #1 – February 17, 2022**
 - City Council and public review maps prepared by demographer
- **Map Review Hearing #2 – February 23, 2022**
 - **Repeat of Map Review Hearing #1**, City Council and public review maps prepared by demographer
- **Map Final Adoption/Sequencing – March 21, 2022**
 - Sequencing – determining the sequence of the elections moving forward
 - Decided after the maps have been prepared (essentially decided at the time Council adopts a final map)
 - NOTE: more information provided as we get closer to this step, just know that the mayor seat is not decided until the maps are prepared and finalized
